The Paschal Candle

The Pashal Candle is prepared for the Easter Vigil. Five grains of incense are inserted in the form of a cross, representing the five wounds of Christ. These are the five brass studs that are inserted into the candle at the four ends of the cross and in the centre.

The first and last letters of the Greek alphabet, Alpha and Omega, are also written on the candle. These two letters represent Christ as the beginning and the end (Revelation 21:6). Lastly, the numbers of the current year, 2024, are written on the candle.

National Pilgrimage for Life

The first National Pilgrimage for Life, organised by the Council for Life of the Irish Catholic Bishops' Conference, will be celebrated on Saturday 4th May in Knock Shrine. The pilgrimage begins with Anointing of the Sick in the Basilica at 2.30pm, with Mass at 3pm and Rosary Procession after Mass, weather permitting. Main celebrant and homilist will be Archbishop Francis Duffy.

What Pope Francis said this week:

On Planet Earth Day, Monday 22nd, he stated: "Our generation has bequeathed many riches, but we have failed to protect the planet and we are not safeguarding peace. We are called to become artisans and caretakers of our common home, the Earth which is "falling into ruin."

About those who deny climate change he commented:

"There are people who are foolish and foolish even if you show them research, they don't believe it," he said.

He pleaded for peace in our world:

"Please. Countries at war, all of them, stop the war. Look to negotiate. Look for peace," Pope Francis told "CBS Evening News" anchor Norah O'Donnell during the hourlong interview on Thursday. "A negotiated peace is better than a war without end".
