BLESSED EDMUND RICE - 5th May

Edmund Rice was born in Callan on June 1, 1762. Following his early education he moved to Waterford where he was apprenticed to his uncle, Michael, who supplied the numerous shops visiting the expanded port. He married in 1785 and a daughter was born to the marriage but soon after his wife died in 1789. Edmund cared for his daughter with the support of his stepsister, Joan. After much discernment and seeing the lack of Christian education among the boys of Waterford, Edmund commenced his great work of Christian education. Two religious congregations, the Christian Brothers and the Presentation Brothers, developed from the foundation which he laid in 1802. Edmund led the Brothers for many years before dying in Waterford in 1844. There are 96 schools in Ireland and worldwide there are 270 schools stretching across the five continents with over 70,000 pupils. In 1996, he was declared "Blessed" by the Church - the first step in the Catholic Church towards sainthood. There are three schools in our diocese: primary schools in Callan and Kilkenny and the CBS Secondary school in Kilkenny. In 2022 the CBS Secondary School in Callan joined with the Mercy Secondary School and Cólaiste Abhainn Rí
