THE LITURGICAL YEAR OF THE CHURCH

seasons (Advent, Christmas, Lent, The Sacred Paschal Triduum, Easter and Ordinary Time) running from December (Advent) through to the end of November (The Feast of Christ the King). This week we re-enter the period called Ordinary Time in the church's calendar. While the word ordinary suggests every day, common and bland, 'ordinary' means a season of 'ordered time'. Usually, 33 or 34 weeks in total Ordinary Time is divided into two sections: one span of 4-8 weeks after Christmas Time and another lasting about six months after Easter Time.

The church's liturgical year is made up of six

This year we will read St Mark's Gospel at Sunday Mass; the first and second readings are from the letters of Paul and Peter and readings from the Prophets and writers of the Old Testament. The readings will take us through the life of Jesus revealing to us the teaching, healing and mission of Christ inviting us to enter the Mystery of Christ more fully. Generally, speaking, the vestments will be green; white vestments are worn on the significant feasts of Christmas, feasts of Our Lady and commemorations of the saints who are not martyrs. Red vestments are worn on Palm Sunday, Good Friday, Pentecost Sunday and on days when we remember the martyrs. Voilet is worn during Advent and Lent. During Ordinary Time the commemoration of the saints will be prominent and feasts of Our Lady will be celebrated - Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes, The Assumption, Our Lady Queen of Heaven, Our Lady of Sorrows, the Feast of the Holy Rosary, .
