CASTLECOMER CO-ED NATIONAL SCHOOL

Following consultation with teachers, boards, parents and pupils of Presentation Primary School and Castlecomer Boys National School and the wider parish community the Boards of Management of both schools met on Wednesday to choose the new name for the planned amalgamated school in Castlecomer. Thanks to all who contributed suggestions; all were considered by the Board members. Bishop Coll, Patron of our Schools, has approved Scoil Íosagáin as the name for the proposed coeducational school which will emerge from the proposed amalgamation. The Boards were keen to have a name in our native language and one that reflects the catholic ethos of our schools. The name will now be forwarded by the Patron to the Department of Education and the process will continue.

WORLD DAY FOR GRANDPARENTS AND ELDERLY:

On Sunday 28 July, the World Day for Grandparents and Elderly will be marked with the annual national grandparents' pilgrimage to the Shrine of our Lady of Knock in the Archdiocese of Tuam. The chief celebrant for Mass will be the Apostolic Nuncio to Ireland, Archbishop Luis Mariano Montemayor in the Basilica at 3.00pm At the gathering Lady of *Knock* will be sung by Dana and anointing of the Sick will take place at 2.30pm. In 2021, Pope Francis announced the establishment of a World Day of Prayer for Grandparents and the Elderly to be celebrated by the Universal Church every year on the fourth Sunday of July, the Sunday closest to the feast of Saints Joachim and Anne, Jesus' grandparents. For this year, Pope Francis' has written a message for the Fourth World Day for Grandparents and Elderly on the theme. Do not cast me off in my old age. (Ps 71:9).
