REACTION TO OLYMPIC OPENING CEREMONY

While the organisers of the Olympics defended the presentation as part of the Opening Ceremony many others expressed abhorrence and disappointment. The French Bishops' Conference in a statement released on Saturday, criticized the "scenes of derision and mockery of Christianity, which we deeply deplore" and grateful to the members of religious denominations who have reached out in the wake of the opening ceremony to express "their solidarity with us."

Bishop Robert Barron of Minnesota, called on Catholics to "make their voices heard" in response to what he called "the gross mockery of the Last Supper. "Would they ever dare mock Islam in a similar way?" Bishop Barron asked, saying, "We all know the answer to that." Catholic French member of European Parliament Marion Maréchale said: "To all the Christians of the world who are watching" the Paris ceremony and "felt insulted by this drag queen parody of the Last Supper, know that it is not France that is speaking but a left-wing minority ready for any provocation."

Elon Musk of X (formerly Twitter) called the spectacle "extremely disrespectful to Christians" House Speaker Mike Johnson of the American House of Representatives calling the tableau "shocking" and "insulting." Italy's Deputy Prime Minister Matteo Salvini branded it insulting and sleazy: "Opening the Olympics by insulting billions of Christians across the world was a bad start.

Meanwhile President of the Paris Olympics Tony Estanguet said "The idea was to really trigger a reflection. We wanted to have a message as strong as possible." The director, Thomas Jolly, was perplexed by negative reactions to the show that turned bridges into settings for the performances. "Our idea was inclusion," Mr Jolly said.
