RENOVATION WORK IN THE PARISH CHURCH:

The work continues in the sanctuary area of the church. Progress is good and both architect and painters are pleased with the progress.

THE OLYMPIC BELL

During the Paris Olympic Games, track and field champions rang a bronze bell located close to the finish line in the stadium. Later this year the bell will be placed in the newly re-opened Notre Dame Cathedral in Parish.

The cathedral's rector, Father Olivier Ribadeau Dumas, was contacted a few months before the Paris Olympics to see if the Paris Cathedral would be interested in this bell for Notre Dame.

The bell, weighing 1,103 lbs., was made by the Cornille Havard foundry located in Normandy. The same company has been responsible for the restoration of eight of these nine bells in the cathedral, after they had been damaged during the fire of April 15, 2019.

The Olympic Games bell will join two other bells, newly cast by the same company, which will ring together during Mass. They will replace the bells that were used before the fire destroyed the site.

LADY WELL, BALLYOUISKIL - SCHOOLS' COLLECTION

Approximately 740,000 pages (288,000 pages in the pupils' original exercise books; 451,000 pages in bound volumes) of folklore and local tradition were compiled by pupils from 5,000 primary schools in the Irish Free State between 1937 and 1939. An account of 'Lady Well' was written by Nellie Ivory from the Convent School in Ballyragget recording the information given to her by Mrs Ivory from Ballycondra, Ballyragget.

The nearest holy well in the district is Lady Well in the parish of Ballyouskil. People visit it on the fifteenth of August. Rounds are performed, the Rosary and other prayers are said and the water is drunk by those who visit the well.

Once when the people in the district came short of water, they got some in the holy well but the water could not be boiled.

No one is known to have been cured by the water of the well and no relics are left there. There is a bush growing over the well.
