CALLING ALL KILLIANS, KILIANS, CILLIANS...

This October an historic pilgrimage will involve the visit of Saint Kilian's relics, along with those of his martyred colleagues Saints Totnan and Kolonat to Ireland from their resting place at the Altar of Würzburg Cathedral in Germany. The relics are contained in a specially preserved glass case inlaid with precious stones. It will be the first time that the relics will have left Germany.

While most of the programme is centred in his native town of Mullagh and the Cathedral in Cavan St Patrick's College Maynooth has been chosen as a stopping point on the journey, with the relics open to the public for veneration in the College Chapel following Vespers at 6.30pm on Wednesday, October 2. The College has issued a special invite to all who share the Saint's name and are calling to all Kilians, Killians or Cillians to attend October 2. Who is Killian? He was a native of Mullagh, Co Cavan it is believed to have received his religious training at a monastery in Rosscarbery, Co. Cork. He later founded his own monastery in Kenmare, Co. Kerry, where he trained his fellow monks and laid plans for a mass pilgrimage from Ireland. From Kilmakilloge harbour Kilian and his twelve companions sailed out on a mission to spread the word on Christianity and like many monks of the 7th century went to Europe where they contributed to the saving of Europe and the Christian civilization which was coming close to extinction. It was while spreading the word in Germany that Kilian and two of his companions, Colman and Totnan, were assassinated in 689AD.
