News from Lourdes via Liverpool

Archbishop Malcolm McMahon of Liverpool has declared cure of Jack Traynor a miracle. Traynor was a pilgrim on the first Liverpool pilgrimage to Lourdes in 1923 and was cured dramatically of epilepsy, paralysis of the right arm and paraplegia during the pilgrimage. The miracle is the 71st to have happened in Lourdes. The Archbishop, following a review of Traynor's case in 2023, declared that "Given the weight of medical evidence, the testimony to the faith of John Traynor and his devotion to Our Lady, it is with great joy that I declare that the cure of John Traynor is to be recognised as a miracle wrought by the power of God through the intercession of Our Lady of Lourdes".
