GOSPEL REFLECTION

Luke 1:1-4; 4:14-21

Saint Luke writes his Gospel so that the reader will "realise the certainty of the teachings" received. That certainty flows from the man in the synagogue who reads the scroll of Isaiah and promised that he will bring glad tidings to the poor, proclaim liberty to captives, give sight to the blind, and let the oppressed go free.

Only God can work such wonders; that is why rejoicing in the Lord in our midst must be our strength. As the eyes of all those assembled in the synagogue looked intently at Jesus, they became an image of what we must do as members of the body of Christ – unite ourselves to him in faith and love.
